Didactic session

Implant Restoration Module

- Single Implant
- Quad restoration (3-4 implants)
- Anterior teeth restoration in the Maxilla
- Jaw restoration
- Full mouth restorations
- All in 4 and All in 6
- Sinus floor lifting with/without placement of implant.
- Bone graft technics, suturing, membranes usage and fixations
- Socket and gum preservation
- Extractions, immediate implant placement. Immediate loading, temporization
- All the stages of the restorations on implants, including temporary and permanent restoration.
- Screw-retained or cement retained, equilibration and concepts of occlusion.
- you may bring your patient or it may be provided for you.
- training is fully supervised by Dr. Yuri and all instruments and materials are provided.
- After successful completion of this course each student will be provided with a certificate of completion credit hours and case documentation for the American Board of Oral Implantology.
